



Henrique Rabelo is an ascending Brazilian pianist

from Rio de Janeiro. He started his music studies in a local public elementary school of arts being 9 years old, then learning the keyboard and the recorder, after which he started studying at the Villa-Lobos Music School, one of the most prestigious institutions in Rio for beginners and intermediate music students. Henrique graduated in 2019 at the Federal University of the State of Rio de Janeiro (UNIRIO), studying with Dr. Erika Ribeiro, one of the leading Brazilian pianists of her generation.

Henrique, now 24 years old, is currently undertaking his Masters in Piano Performance with Dr. Theresa Bogard at the University of Wyoming, working as a graduate assistant at the institution, collaborating with instrumentalists and singers, playing for choirs, orchestras and ensembles, and teaching. He has performed regularly across Brazil in important halls, and has been awarded a number of prizes in piano competitions. His main interests comprise a big variety of repertoire, from Baroque to Contemporary, chamber music, as well as historical performance practices, fortepiano, composition, audio technology and jazz.

As a proud Introvert, Henrique prefers to cultivate few but valuable friendships. Some of his hobbies include playing chess, reading books, video editing and spending time with friends. After his Masters, Henrique intends to continue his academic journey pursuing an Artistic Diploma or a Doctoral Degree in the US.


